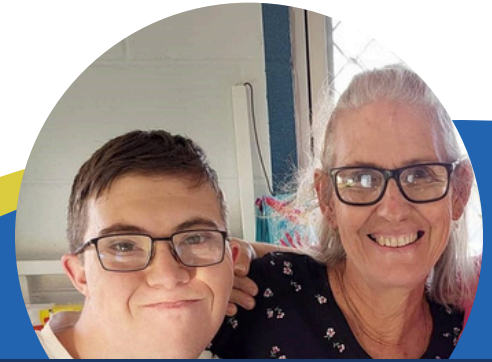




Getting your Supports on the Right Track
